Dear David,

We are pleased to send you the attached materials which describe the agenda for our November conference on the Holocaust and list many of the participants. We have every reason to believe that the conference will be a truly substantial one and that the three days we spend together in intensive study and discussion will be unusually productive.

As stated in our previous correspondence with you, travel, housing and meal expenses will be covered by us. Housing accommodations are for a double-occupancy room. Should you prefer to have a single room, the difference will be approximately \$12 to \$14 per day -- this sum to be borne by you. Please notify us soon which arrangement suits you best. Should you prefer to share a room with another of the conference participants, please so indicate in your reply and we shall make the necessary arrangements.

Because air fares will be increasing at least twice between now and our November meetings, it is desirable that we secure your tickets as soon as possible. We would like to schedule a Sunday, November 2nd mid-afternoon flight for you from La Guardia to Indianapolis. Since schedules will change on October 1st, we will issue new tickets if necessary showing any flight time changes, thus voiding the first ticket which you will be receiving during this summer. If for some reason you prefer an alternate time, please so indicate to us and we shall be glad to comply. In order to help us facilitate your return flight, we would like to schedule your departure for La Guardia as close to mid-morning on Thursday, November 6th, as possible. Again, if you prefer an alternate time please notify us and we will do our best.

If the flights we schedule are convenient for you, we can then arrange to have transportation ready at the Indianapolis Airport to take you and other arriving participants to Bloomington. The ride is approximately one hour.

The Indiana University Press will be hosting a reception for conference participants on the evening of Sunday, November 2nd. The reception promises to be a cordial affair and will allow us all to become acquainted before the formal work of the conference begins on Monday morning.

Kosher food will be available for those who request it. Please indicate your dietary preferences on the enclosed card and mail it back to us at your earliest convenience.
