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CHAPTER ONE: INTRODUCTION

1.1 County Background Information

Homa Bay County in Kenya is situated on the shores of Lake Victoria, known for its picturesque landscapes and vibrant community life. Popularly known as the Bay County, because of its many bays, Homa Bay County has population of 963,794 and an area of 3,183.3 km². About 80% of Kenya's Lake Victoria is in Homabay County, making the county the leading supplier of fresh lake fish in Kenya. Homa Bay County is divided into eight sub-counties: Mbita, Ndhiwa, Homa Bay Town, Rangwe, Karachuonyo, Kabondo, Kasipul, and Suba. And 40 wards represented by Members of the County Assembly (MCAs).

1.2 The Legal Framework for Participatory Budgeting

Public participation is a constitutional mandate in the County Governance. Article 1 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 states that sovereign power belongs to the people and in Article 10 (2) (a) and the Fourth Schedule Part 2 (14) of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 public

participation is stipulated as a function of the County Government. Section 115 (1) and Section 87 of the County Government Act No. 17 of 2012 also provides that citizen participation in county processes as mandatory and principles of citizen participation in Counties. Section 184 of Urban Areas and Cities Act, 2012 provides for participation by residents in the governance of urban areas and cities.

Sections 125 (2) of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 outlines that the County Executive Committee Member for Finance shall ensure that there is public participation in the budget process.

Public participation in the budgeting process leads to allocation of resources to community priority projects and programs thus attributing to sustainable development

1.3 Objectives Of 2026/27 Budget Public Participation

The budget participation objectives were to;

- a) To facilitate community feedback on projects and programs implemented in FY 2024/25 & 2025/26 budgets as a basis for equity and prioritization of FY 2026/27 budget.
- b) Mapping of development partners implementing projects in the County.
- c) Prioritization of projects/programs linked ADP 2026/27
- d) Enhancing the public participation quality and legitimacy



1.4 FY2025/26 Budget Participation Guiding Principles

The participation and identification of projects for FY 2026/27 budget was guided by the following principles;

- a) **Inclusion and Participation:** Facilitators Ensured that all relevant stakeholders, including marginalized groups, have the opportunity to participate in the budget process. Every ward had a minimum Of 20 participants invited from the community.
- b) **Transparency:** The relevant budget information was readily accessible and understandable to the public, fostering accountability and trust.
- c) **Focus on Outcomes:** Focus was on the impact of budget decisions on the community, and aligning budget priorities with citizen needs and priorities.
- d) **Empowerment:** Citizens were provided with the knowledge and tools to effectively participate in the budget process and influence decision-making.
- e) **Civic Participation:** The process aimed at encouraging and enabling citizens to engage in public life and hold their government accountable.



CHAPTER TWO: 2026/27 BUDGET PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS

2.1 Public Participation Approach

The analysis of our county's public participation process has led to a new criterion for FY 2026/27. The Paradigm highlights change in the public participation model based on difficulties, lessons learned, and possibilities in the county's public engagement for development/devolved service delivery.

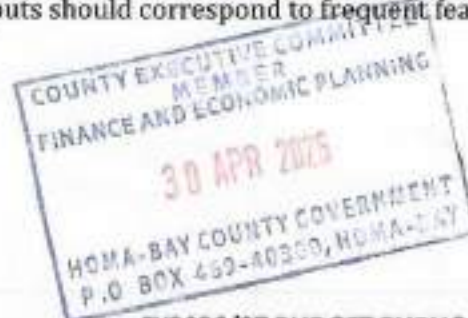
2.7 Summary Of Public Participation Levels and Attendance

The forums were attended by **892** participants at the ward level, 60 technical staffs from various sectors. And other key officials from the County Government top management. The participants at the ward and municipality level included **261**(youths), **525**(35-59yrs), **82**(elderly) and **24** (PWDs).

2.8 Community Feedback and Recommendation on 2024/25 Projects

The community gave the following feedback on the FY 2024/25 budget projects;

- i. Some projects are allocated funds and have not started. Implementation to be considered. Since the community are in dire need of the project's outcome. I.e Kabdala -Ranganya road in Ndhiwa sub county.
- ii. Timely implementation of projects. I.e Disbursement of farm inputs.
- iii. The projects should be implemented exactly as the community have proposed. Not to be interfered with and budget estimated done as per the proposals by the community.
- iv. Consider equality and equity in resource allocation
- v. Some projects were under funded by the sectors/departments slowing down community uptake.
- vi. Contractors should work in harmony with the PMCs and the community
- vii. PMCs allowances are not being paid
- viii. Completed projects should be commissioned and handed over to the community.
- ix. There is still vandalization of county projects. I.e water taps stolen with the notion they are made of gold. More awareness and sensitization to be done on the project's importance and benefits.
- x. More playing field to be upgraded to encourage sports and nurture talents.
- xi. PWDs need to be considered on the various projects I.e making Governor's office accessible
- xii. Tender awarding process be more transparent and consideration not to be given to county staffs
- xiii. Some projects are poorly done by the contractors, ensure there is proper technical supervision during the implementation of the projects
- xiv. Some projects are stated complete yet the state they are in, they cannot be used. I.e classrooms, the windows and doors for Arina Primary EYE are yet to be installed. Projects should be done to a level where they are operational
- xv. Selection of farm inputs should correspond to frequent feasibility studies for high yield.

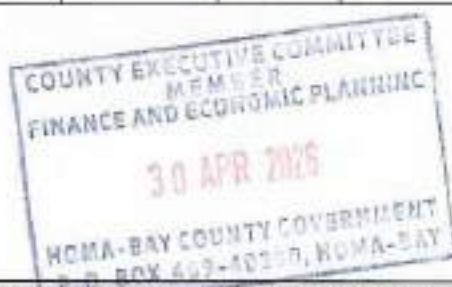

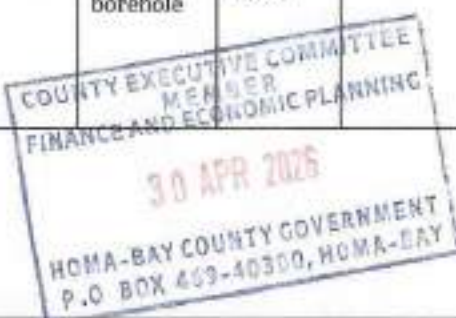
