FOREWORD

The Budget for FY 2026/27 has been developed in strict adherence with the Constitution of Kenya and key legislation, including the Public Finance Management Act (PFMA) of 2012, the County Governments Act of 2012, and the Urban Areas and Cities Act of 2011. In line with Articles 201 and 232 of the Constitution, as well as Sections 125, 131(6), and 207 of the PFMA, and Sections 87, 91, and 115 of the County Governments Act, the County has ensured citizen involvement in the budgeting process, fulfilling legal requirements for public participation, transparency, and accountability.

The FY 2026/27 budget, under the theme *"Consolidating the Gains under the GENOWA Economic Transformation Agenda for Inclusive Green Growth,"* focuses on strategic priorities aimed at enhancing service delivery and sustainable development. These include upgrading Early Childhood Education facilities under the Ondo Kaunda Initiative, improving the county's road network, expanding access to clean and affordable green energy, investing in lakefront infrastructure to boost the blue economy, increasing access to safe water in informal settlements, and finalizing key health projects such as the Accident & Emergency Centre at the County Referral Hospital.

The total resource envelope for FY 2026/27 is KShs. **12,104,350,747**, comprising KShs. **8,914,134,592** Equitable Share, KShs. **1,305,104,867** in Conditional Grants, KShs. **1,671,077,323** Own Source Revenue, including KShs. **1,104,906,565** in Appropriations-in-Aid (A-In-A) for Health and Ordinary Own Source Revenue at KShs. **566,180,758**; and KShs. **214,023,965** for the equalization Fund.

To manage the wage bill, the County is implementing sustainability measures. These include continuous payroll audits, staff replacement through attrition, and merit-based hiring, to ensure compliance with the 35% personnel expenditure ceiling outlined in the PFMA.

Public participation forums held across municipalities have ensured that citizen voices shape local priorities. This reinforces the County's commitment to inclusive governance and equitable development.

The County appreciates all stakeholders for their contributions and looks forward to a successful implementation phase that builds on the GENOWA agenda and unlocks the County's full potential.

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INTRODUCTION

Legal Framework for the Citizens' Budget

The preparation and publication of the Citizen's Budget are governed by the following laws:

a) Constitution of Kenya, 2010

- ✓ **Article 201:** Promotes openness, accountability, and public participation in public finance.
- ✓ **Article 232:** Emphasizes transparency and responsiveness in public service.

b) Public Finance Management Act (PFMA), 2012

- ✓ **Section 6(2):** Mandates the County Treasury to publish a Citizen's Budget in an accessible format.
- ✓ **Section 125:** Details the county budget process and requires public participation.
- ✓ **Section 131(6):** Requires budget documents to be publicized within 21 days of approval.
- ✓ **Section 207:** Stipulates transparency and accountability in county finance management.

c) County Governments Act, 2012

- ✓ **Section 87:** Outlines principles for citizen participation in governance.
- ✓ **Section 91:** Establishes citizen engagement platforms.
- ✓ **Section 115:** Requires public involvement in county planning and budgeting.

d) Urban Areas and Cities Act, 2011:

- ✓ Ensures public participation in urban governance.

e) County Government Regulations, 2015:

- ✓ Reinforces the need for effective public participation in budget preparation and the publication of a Citizen's Budget.

BUDGET ECONOMIC ASSUMPTIONS

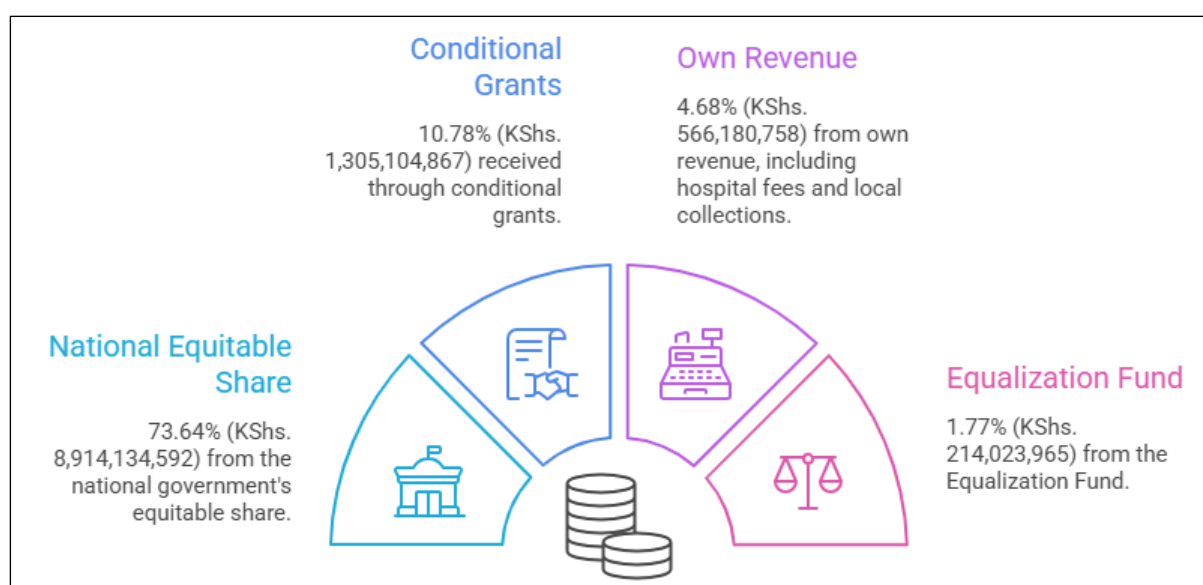
- I. **National Economic Growth**
Kenya's economy is expected to grow by about **5.5% to 6.0%**, supported by better farming activities, government investments, and growing businesses. A stronger economy means more jobs and income for people.
- II. **Stable Prices (Inflation)**
The cost of goods and services (inflation) is expected to remain stable at around **5%**, which helps families afford basic items like food, transport, and fuel.
- III. **Exchange Rate Stability**
The value of the Kenyan shilling is expected to stabilize, making it easier for the County to buy goods and services that come from outside the country.
- IV. **Revenue Collection**
The County expects to raise more local revenue through improved systems, enforcement, and technology.
- V. **Intergovernmental Transfers**
An increase in the Equitable Share, Conditional Allocations and share of equalisation from the National Government is anticipated, reflecting national revenue growth and updated CRA recommendations. It also expects more support through the timely and full disbursement of these funds.
- VI. **Wage Bill Control**
The County plans to spend carefully on salaries, keeping it within the law by ensuring it doesn't exceed 35% of total revenue.
- VII. **Favorable Weather**
Good weather is expected, which supports farming, water supply, and food security. The County is also planning for any climate-related risks by providing certified drought-resistant seeds.
- VIII. **Peace and Good Governance**
The budget assumes a peaceful environment and continued collaboration between the County and National Governments to support development projects.
- IX. **Public Participation**
The County will continue involving residents in decision-making, so that the budget reflects the real needs and priorities of the people.

BUDGET FISCAL FRAMEWORK, FY2026/27

For the financial year 2026/27, the County Government of Homa Bay has approved a budget of KShs. **12,104,350,747**. Out of this, KShs. **3,700,307,266** (representing 30.6%) will go towards development projects like roads, health facilities, and agriculture, while KShs. **8,404,043,481** (representing 69.4%) will be used for day-to-day running of the county (recurrent expenses like salaries and operations).



To fund its 2026/27 budget, Homa Bay County expects to raise KShs. **12,104,350,747** from various sources. The largest share 73.64% (KShs. **8,914,134,592**) will come from the national government's equitable share, 10.78% (KShs. **1,305,104,867**) will be received through conditional grants, and 1.77% (KShs. **214,023,965**) from the Equalization Fund. The County also plans to generate 4.68% (KShs. **566,180,758**) from its own revenue, including hospital fees and local collections.



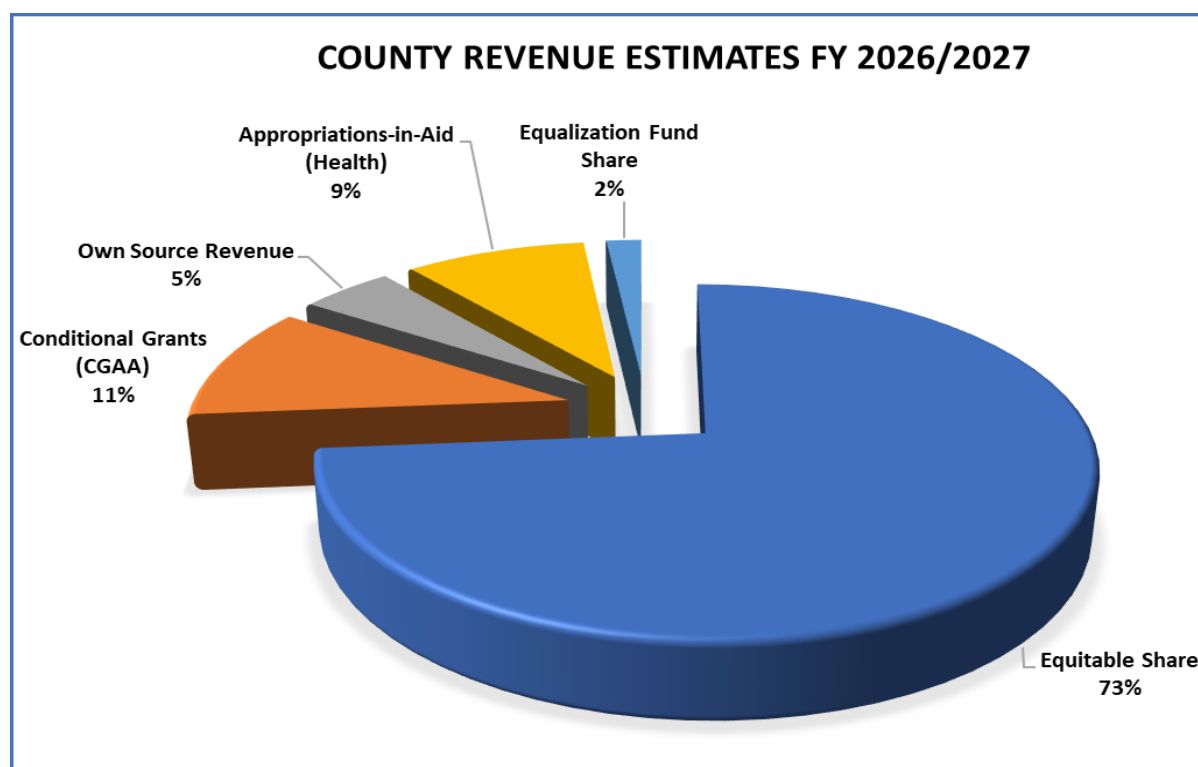

Revenue Estimates by Sources and Expenditure by Economic Classification

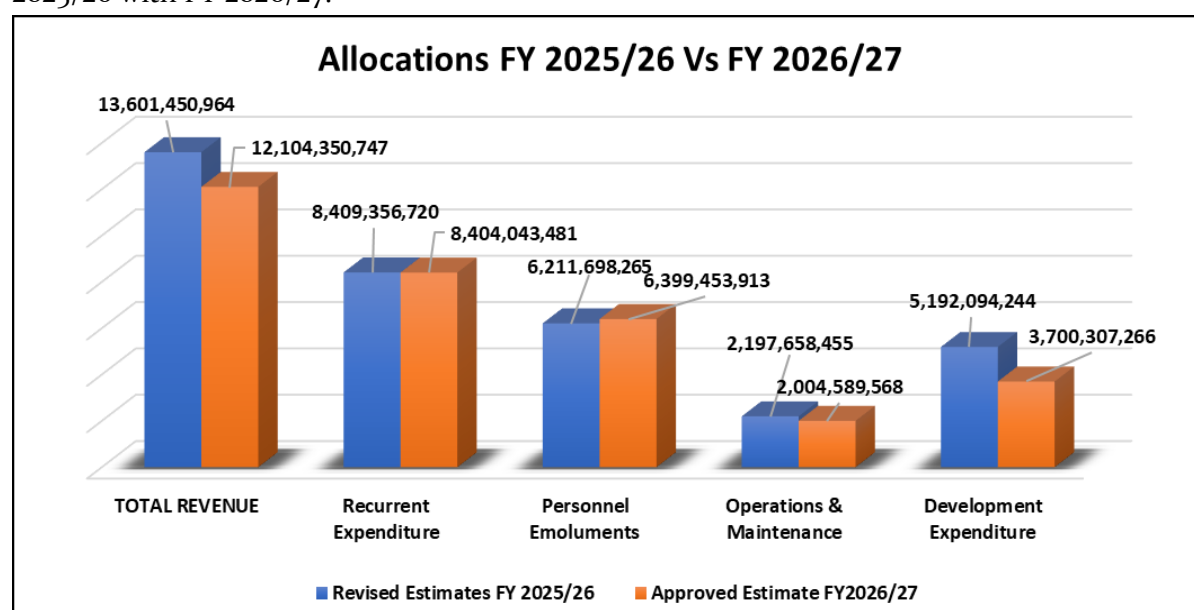

Compared with FY 2025/26, the Revenue Estimates for FY 2026/27 has dropped by KSh. 1.491 billion, which is largely attributed to the expected decrease in conditional grants by KSh. 1.124 billion. Besides, the unspent balances have not been recognized since the budget preparation process concluded before the end of the FY 2025/26.

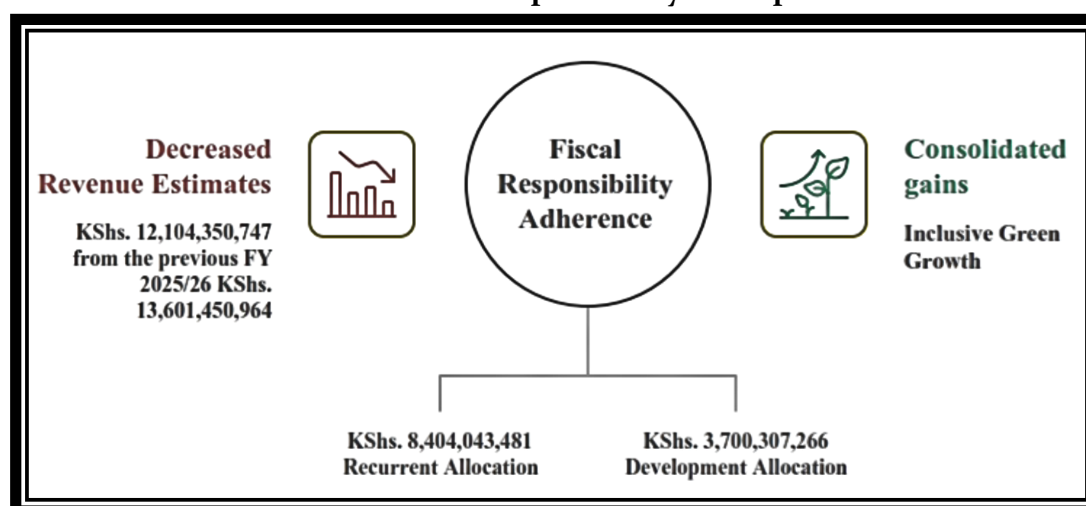
County Revenue Projections by Source for FY 2026/2027

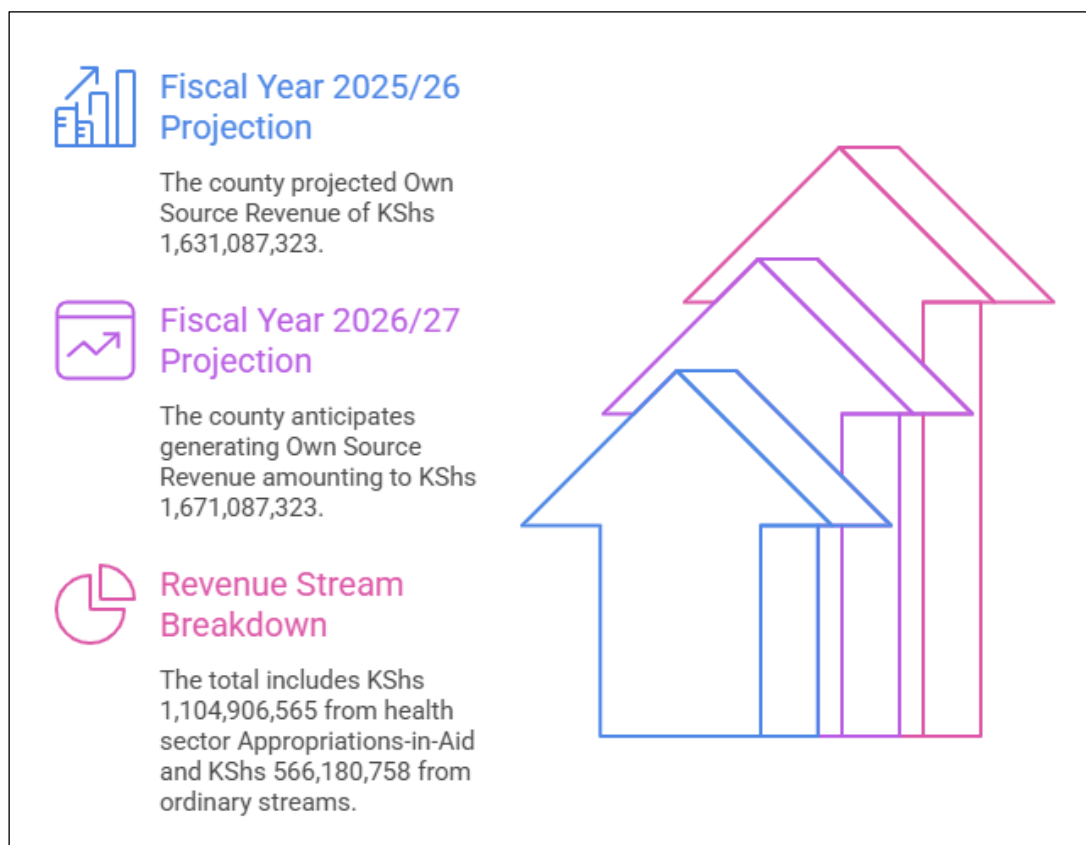

Generally, the decrease in conditional Grants from KSh. 2.425 billion in FY 2025/26 and KSh. 1.305 billion is mainly explained by the KISIIP, Road Maintenance Fuel Levy (which have not been provided for in the CGAA Act 2026) and NAVCDP which has been reduced by 50%.

Own Source Revenue Projection

In the financial year 2026/27, the county anticipates generating Own Source Revenue (OSR) amounting to KShs **1,671,087,323**. This total includes KShs. **1,104,906,565** from Appropriations-in-Aid (A-I-A) from the health sector and KSh. **566,180,758** from the ordinary OSR streams. This represents a modest increase compared to the projected KSh. **1,631,087,323** for the fiscal year 2025/26.

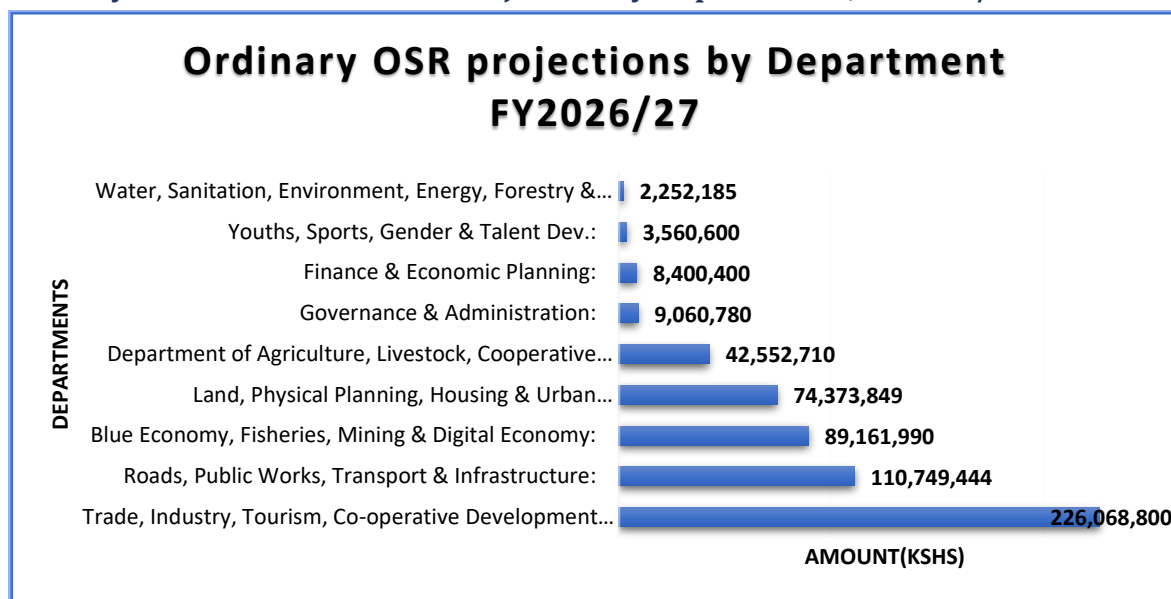


Projections of Own Source Revenue by Source, FY 2026/27 (in KShs.)

Ordinary Own Source Revenue Projection by Departments, FY2026/27



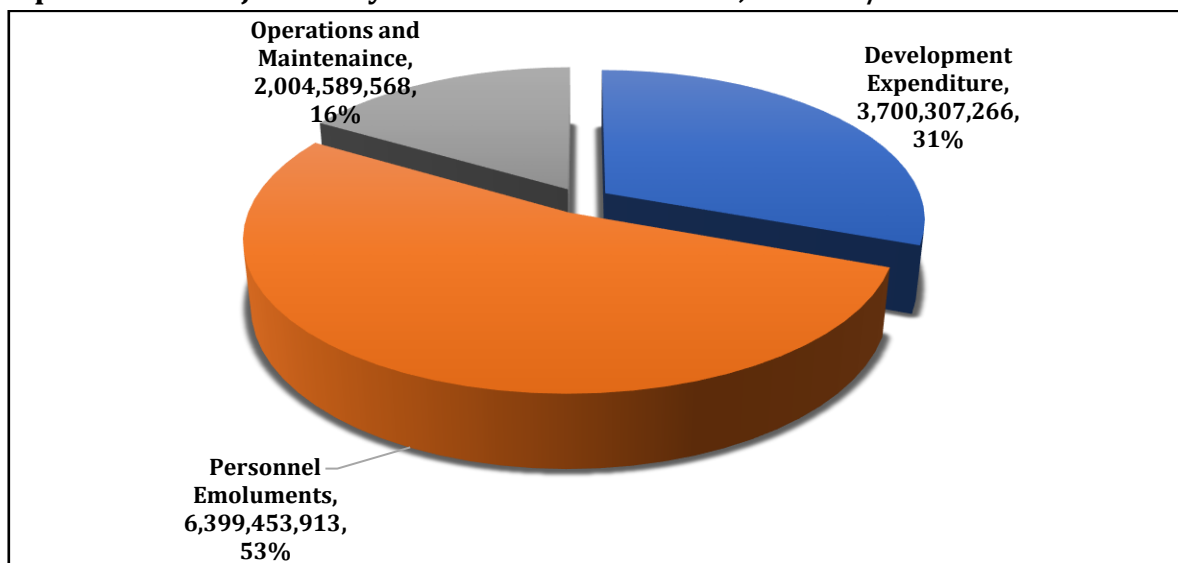

EXPENDITURE ESTIMATES

In the budget estimates for FY 2026/27, the County Government of Homa Bay is expected to incur expenditure amounting to KShs. **12,104,350,747**, which consists of KShs. **8,404,043,481** (representing 69.4%) set aside for recurrent expenditures while KShs **3,700,307,266** (representing 30.6%) for development expenditures. Out of the Approved recurrent expenditure, KShs. **6,399,453,913** will cater for personnel emoluments while KShs. **2,004,589,568** will cover operations and maintenance.
