

## \*1041.—Royal Marines—Wearing of Medals and Ribbons.

(N.L. 4399/22.—14.4.1922.)

Pending the introduction of the Cloth Tunic, Medals and Medal Ribbons are to be worn by Royal Marines as follows :—

*Medals*.—To be worn on

*Frock*.—When worn for walking out.

*Service Dress, Blue or Khaki*.—When Review Order is ordered.

*Position*.—To be worn in the order laid down in K.R. and A.I., Art. 167, suspended from a single bar which is to be attached to the garment, one inch down and one inch back from the top button-hole. The ribbon to be one inch in length, or if clasps are worn, one inch from the uppermost clasp to the top of the ribbon. When medals cannot on account of their number be suspended so as to be freely seen they are to overlap.
