

1753.—Dress—Royal Marine Officers—Wearing of Worsted Badges of Rank on
Khaki Battledress

(R.M. 15/12/7.—28 May 1948.)

Bronze badges of rank, at present worn by Royal Marine Officers on khaki
battledress, will be replaced by the $\frac{1}{4}$ -in. worsted badge on the scarlet infantry
background.

2. As the worsted badges will not be available on repayment from Clothing
Stores, Officers are required to provide themselves with appropriate badges at the
earliest opportunity.

3. Brass badges will continue to be worn on blue battledress.
4. The Appendix to the Navy List will be amended in due course.
