

\*2713.—Uniform—Chief Petty Officers.

(V. 2478.—18.9.1925.)

The wearing of three large gilt buttons on the cuffs of jackets and white tunics, hitherto restricted to certain Chief Petty Officers only, is extended to all Chief Petty Officers, and the Uniform Regulations will be amended accordingly.

2. Men concerned are to make the change at their own expense and are to be allowed to wear out any jackets or tunics they have of the existing pattern.
