

*3504.—Royal Marines—Boy Buglers and Boy Musicians.

(N. 5120/25.—18.12.1925.)

It has been decided to adopt the titles "Boy Bugler" and "Boy Musician" for all boys enlisting in the Royal Marines after 4th October, 1925, for service as Buglers or in the Division Bands. Rates of pay of these boys were promulgated in A.F.O. 2859/25.

2. Boy Buglers and Boy Musicians are to be advanced to Bugler or Musician, respectively, on attaining the age of 18 years, a notation of such advancement being made in the rank column on Service Certificate.

3. The necessary amendments to K.R. & A.I., Appendix XV, Part I, will be promulgated in due course.
