

**3646.—Uniform—R.M.F.V.R.—Buttonhole Badge**

(V. 1D/4823/51.—5 Dec. 1952.)

A buttonhole badge for wear by R.M.F.V.R. officers and ratings when not in uniform has been approved by H.M. The Queen. The badge is intended to be worn on the lapel of the coat.

2. The design of the badge is a silver globe surrounded by a gilt laurel wreath, with a gilt lion and crown above, and the letters R.M.F.V.R., in gilt on a blue background, below.

3. The badge is issued on loan to all permanent R.M.F.V.R. personnel by R.M.F.V.R. centres to whom detailed arrangements for issue have been communicated.
