

4648.—Uniform for T.124X Radio Officers

(N.L. 11632/40.—19.12.1940.)

Their Lordships have approved the uniform to be worn by Radio Officers appointed without commissions under T.124X agreement.

2. These officers will wear the cap badge which has been approved for officers employed under T.124 agreement.

3. Buttons of mercantile marine pattern will be worn on the uniform jacket.

4. The cuff badge which will be worn on the uniform jacket is as follows :—

(i) Senior Radio Officers :

Two bands of gold lace, R.N.V.R. type, $\frac{1}{4}$ -in. wide, filled by $\frac{1}{4}$ -in. stripe of pale green material, with superimposed diamond ($1\frac{1}{2}$ -in. high) of $\frac{1}{4}$ -in. gold lace, the centre filled with pale green material.

(ii) 2nd Radio Officers :

Two bands of gold lace as above with pale green stripe as above.

(iii) 3rd Radio Officers :

One band of gold lace as above, but $\frac{1}{4}$ -in. wide, with $\frac{1}{4}$ -in. pale green stripe attached below.
