

529.—Uniform—Badges—Royal Marines—Colour Sergeants Arm Badge—
Re-Introduction

(V.2C/62/13/54.—1 Mar. 1957.)

It has been decided to re-introduce, for wear on the present No. 1 Dress, the Ceremonial Arm Badge formerly worn on best blue uniform suits by Colour Sergeants, Royal Marines. The badge which is slightly smaller than the former pattern is designated **Badge Arm, Colour Sergeant, Vocab. No. 31927**. It is to be worn on the right arm above the chevrons in place of the crown at present in use.

2. Arrangements for the introduction of the new badge are:—

- (a) Serving Colour Sergeants to receive an initial free issue of one badge.
- (b) Sergeants promoted in future to receive an initial free issue of one badge in lieu of one Crown, Colour Sergeant, Vocab. No. 31922.
