

(U)1173.—Uniform—Badges—The RN School of Nursing—Training School Badge

(N/MDG 321/6/71/C—29 Oct 71)

1. The Royal Naval School of Nursing badge is presented to naval male and female student and pupil nurses who successfully complete training at the Royal Naval School of Nursing and obtain the qualification of State Registered Nurse or State Enrolled Nurse.
2. The badge, which is free, is presented by the Director of Naval Medical Staff Training when student and pupil nurses have obtained registration or enrolment with the General Nursing Council, as appropriate.
3. Applications for replacement of badges are to be made through Commanding Officers to the Director of Naval Medical Staff Training with a brief statement of the circumstances.
4. The charge for replacement of badges lost by neglect is currently 28p.
