3. Helmets and greatcoats to be worn when ordered.
4. WO2s and below wear AP boots. Overalls, wellington boots and spurs to be worn by Majors and above, Adjts, Equerries, MAs, ADCs and Flag Lts.
5. Offrs only (WO1s wear OP lanyard).
6. SNCOs wear white belt and scarlet sash; WO2s wear a sword belt and scarlet sash. Sam Browne always worn with frog, whether carrying sword or not.
7. Swords/Rifles are carried on parade or when ordered.
8. WO2s, Drum and Bugle Majors on appointment and above wear brown cape gloves; the remainder wear white gloves.
9. Not provided at public expense. The alternative sock is Combat Sock GS.
