Introduction

1. This DCI announces the introduction of an anodized badge for wear on the wrist by Coxswains in the Submarine Service. The badge will be worn on the right wrist by CPO Coxswains (SM) in numbers 2A, 2J, 2N, 4, 6, 7, 7A, 8J and 10 Dress.

Background

2. Coxswains in submarines perform disciplinary and regulatory duties similar to those of the Master-At-Arms in ships, but whereas the latter are identifiable in all forms of Dress Coxswains (SM) are not. It has therefore been decided to provide a metal badge for wear on a wrist strap so that they can be recognized visibly in the performance of their duties.

Design

3. The anodized badge consists of a Coxswains' wheel encircled by a laurel wreath. A pair of lugs is positioned on the badge to facilitate fitting to the wrist strap which is in white leather.

Introductory and supply arrangements

4. Gratuitous issue of one badge and one wrist strap is to be made on promotion to CPO Coxswain (SM) and to all personnel currently serving in the rate.

5. Demands for the new badge should be placed on PSTO(N) Devonport.

6. Storekeeping and accounting details are shown in the ANNEX.

Publications

7. BR 81, RN and RM Uniform Regulations will be amended. *In the meantime a copy of this DCI is to be retained within the covers of the BR until its contents have been incorporated by routine amendment.*
