## IV. EQUIPMENT, STORES AND SERVICING

67/86 STORES—CLOTHING—ISSUING PRICES OF RN, RM, QARNNS AND  
WRNS OFFICERS' CLOTHING (U)

[D/ST83/106/3/37]

1. Issuing prices of items in the officers' clothing range have been reviewed in the light of current costs. Revised prices to be brought into force from 1 Apr 86 are shown in the ANNEXES to this DCI:

- ANNEX A : Issuing prices of Naval officers' clothing
- ANNEX B : Issuing prices of RM officers' clothing
- ANNEX C : Issuing prices of QARNNS officers' clothing
- ANNEX D : Issuing prices of WRNS officers' clothing

*Notes:*

1. The letter O after description indicates that the item is obsolescent and available from Service sources only while stocks remain.
2. The symbol < indicates an increase in price.
3. The symbol > indicates a decrease in price.
4. Revised prices for made-to-measure items are not yet available pending receipt of new contracts commencing 1 Apr 86. These prices will be promulgated separately.
2. VAT is to be charged on the sale of all cash clothing except:
  - a. In Fleet establishments abroad.
  - b. In HM ships outside territorial waters for more than 15 days or where a voyage of less than 15 days includes a call at a foreign port.
  - c. Where items are being purchased under the Personal Export Scheme (*see* BR 96 Part III Art 0482).
3. Revised rates of officers' Uniform Upkeep Allowances effective from 1 Apr 86 will be promulgated separately.
4. To assist supply officers in highlighting the more substantial price increases/decreases those items showing price variations greater than £1.00 up or down at VAT exclusive rates have been underlined in ANNEXES A to D. It will be noted that there have been substantial price increases on RSNs V026-99-1385722/5735 Cap Covers stone coloured, V026-99-1222622/2624 Gaiters, V026-99-1388386/8417 Bush jackets and V026-99-4151142/1155 Trousers white drill. These are due to there having been no purchases of these items for some years and reflect the increased cost of materials.
5. Ratings and RM warrant officers, NCOs and men. Issuing prices of clothing for ratings and RM warrant officers, non-commissioned officers and men, Kit Upkeep Allowances (KUA) and clothing gratuities remain as published in DCI RN 370/85 and later DCIs for new items and are to continue in force until 31 Jul 86.
6. Documentation. A copy of this DCI is to be retained within the covers of BR 1246A until superseded.
