

(U)994.—Uniform—Badges—Airborne Missile Aimers

(DGST(D of V)(N)/N/AWD 43/69—3 Sep 71)

1. A special skill badge has been introduced for wear by ratings qualified as Airborne Missile Aimers and is to be awarded to helicopter crewmen on satisfactory completion of the course for qualification as SS11/AS12 aimer. The design represents an AS12 missile over a lightning flash.
2. *Manner of wear.*—The badge is to be worn on the right cuff as for other skill badges in accordance with BR 81 (*Uniform Regulations*) Articles 0438 (2) and 0441. Qualified ratings may also be allowed optionally to wear the badge on the right breast-pocket of flying overalls.
3. *Issue.*—Qualified Airborne Missile Aimers at present serving and those qualifying in future are to be given under the arrangements set out in Chapter 11 of BR 93 (*Victualling Manual*) an initial gratuitous issue of 1 No gold and 1 No red badge and also 2 No blue embroidered badges when required for tropical clothing. Badges are available from PSTO(N), HM Dockyard, Devonport, Plymouth PL1 4SR. The Vocabulary Numbers are:
