The following Badges are approved for wear by N.C.O's and men of the R. Artillery who pass the necessary tests:—

AYER'S BADGE	“L” in Wreath.
RANGETAKER'S BADGE	“R” in Wreath.
FIELD SURVEY BADGE	Crown and “S” in Wreath (1st. Class), in Wreath (2nd Class).

2. Qualifications required for these Badges are as follows:—

AYER'S BADGE.

“L” in Wreath

(a) For Corporals and Gunners who successfully pass the Layer's Test as laid down in Army Drill Books for the Field Army Artillery.

(b) For Corporals and Gunners who successfully pass all the tests laid down in G.A.T., Vol. I., Appendix IV, Layers (Coast Defence).

(c) For Corporals and Gunners who successfully pass the tests laid down for Layers of Anti-Aircraft Battalions.

RANGETAKER'S BADGE.

“R” in Wreath

(a) For Corporals and Gunners who successfully pass the tests laid down in G.A.T., Vol. I., for Range (Coast Defence).

(b) For Corporals and Gunners who successfully pass the Army Tests as Rangetakers for A. A. Artillery.

FIELD SURVEY BADGE.
Crown and “S” in
Wreath (1st. Class).

For N.C.O's and men who qualify in all branches of the Survey Course.

“S” in Wreath (2nd
Class).

For N.C.O's and men who qualify in one or more branches at the Survey Course.
