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Dress Regulations—Officers.

Attention is called to the re-numbering of paragraphs of the Dress Regulations and to the alterations in the following paragraphs on pages 848 *et seq.* of the current Quarterly Navy List, viz.:—

Paragraphs 10, 20, 21, 25, 31, and 34.

2. In paragraph 31, lines 8 and 9, *delete* the words “two at back,” and *for* “rounded” *read* “square.”
3. Officers may continue to wear the old pattern blue helmet until the 1st January 1908.
4. The old pattern F.S. cap for R.M.A., and the existing embroidered collar badge and badges of rank of the blue frock, R.M.A., now in possession of Officers may be worn out.
5. The F.S. cap is only to be worn on shore by Officers on fatigue, at field training, musketry, or gunnery, or at night. Except as herein specified, it is not to be worn by Officers either on or off duty. On board ship this cap is not to be worn in harbour between sunrise and sunset.
