cord, embroidered gold
grenades on collar, and
with lyre and crown on
wrist. Tweed Trowsers,
with gold lace stripes.

Undress	...	Forage Cap, blue cloth, with gold embroidered drooping peak, gold lace band, 1½ inch wide, gold purl button, with braided figure on crown. Frock Coat, blue cloth, No. 1, trimmed as for Bandmaster, R.A. (present pattern), with gold lyre and crown on wrist. Tweed Trowsers, with scarlet superfine cloth stripe.
Appointments, &c.	...	

(a) The Full Dress and Undress Trowsers are to be issued alternately.

(b) The Helmet, Pouch, and Belt will, when required, be purchased through the Director of Contracts, and the buttons, olivet, mohair cord, and the distinguishing badge demanded from the R.A.C. Depôt.

Helmet, Officers' pattern. Cloth Tunic, trimmed with gold lace and braid, and with shoulder knots (Officers' pattern) of plaited gold cord. Tweed Trowsers, with gold lace stripes.

Forage Cap, blue cloth with gold embroidered drooping peak, gold lace band, $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches wide, gold purl button and braided figure on crown. Patrol Jacket of the same pattern as that worn by a 2nd Lieutenant, R.M.L.I., with a gold lyre and crown on wrist. To be issued biennially, dating from the last issue of the garment, or from the last payment of clothing compensation. Tweed Trowsers, with scarlet superfine cloth stripes, 2 inches wide.

Appointments, &c, ...

Pouch and Belt (over left shoulder) with lyre and crown on the breast and lion and crown with scroll on pouch. Sword and Scabbard, Belt and Knot, Staff Sergeants. Boots, Gloves, Great Coat and Cape, as other Warrant Officers.

(a) The Full Dress and Undress Trowsers are to be issued alternately.

(b) A pattern for style and trimming of Cloth Tunic has been approved for guidance, and, when required, application for it is to be made to the Deputy Adjutant-General.

(c) The Helmet, Pouch, and Belt are, when required, to be purchased as directed in paragraph 136 (b).

(d) The quantity of gold lace allowed for the Gold lace
Tunic will be as follows:— for Tunic.

Gold Lace, $\frac{1}{2}$ inch ... 1 yard (for collar).
" 1 " ... 4 " (for fronts, cuffs,
and back seams).

(e) The 1-inch lace and distinguishing badge are
to be specially demanded when required
for use, and the shoulder knots and screw
buttons purchased locally at a cost not to
exceed 10s. 6d. and 1s. respectively.

137 (a). The dress of the Bandmaster-Sergeant
R.M. Depôt, will be similar to that of the Senior
Band Sergeants of the R.M.L.I. Divisions, except
that he will not wear chevrons, and his arm badge
will be a lyre and crown, gold. He will wear a
Pouch and Belt as for Bandmaster and a Cap of
Officers' pattern.
