

The badges now obsolete are those marked on attached Form. Pattern numbers and description of new badges are as follows:-
 Patt. 262. Globe & Laurel, Gilt, with separate Lion & Crown, with pins.
 Patt. 263. Globe Laurel, Lion & Crown, Gilt, with pins.
 Patt. 264. Globe Laurel, Lion & Crown, Gilding Metal, with pins.
 No alteration is necessary as regards the age of metal.

2. Patterns of the above badges have been sealed and forwarded to the Admiralty Pattern Rooms.

3. All obsolete patterns, except Grenades, Gilt and G.M. have been withdrawn from Pattern Rooms. The letters "R.M.A" and "R.M.L.I" will not be withdrawn at present, it being necessary for Contractors to see Old and New titles. Patterns of the letters "R.M" are at present being altered and will be forwarded to the Pattern Rooms when sealed.

4. The actual No. of Shoulder Titles R.M.A. and R.M.L.I. Gilt and G.M. requiring alteration, will be notified in a few days.
