CIRCULAR

Supply of R.M. Police Buttonhole Badges.

Arrangements have been made for supply of 2,000 "Globe and Laurel, white metal with letters R.M.P. below" as follows :-

Chatham Division, R.M. 690 (460 for Chatham Area and 230 for Scottish Area).

Portsmouth Division, R.M. 740

Plymouth Division, R.M. 570

2. These badges are for wear by R.M. Police and R.M.P. Special Reserve in plain clothes.

3. On receipt at Divisions, all these badges are to be issued outright to Area Police Officers for disposal, claims being raised against the pertinent Vote. (S.I. Art. 32). Future issues from R.M. Divisions (except on repayment) will also be made to Area Police Officers, who will be responsible for their custody and disposal.

4. Cost of the badges, at £2 = 2 - 0 per gross, will be shown as an excess in current Vote 2 "N" Estimates. (D.o.F. C.).

5. 144 "Globe and Laurel, white metal with letters R.M.P. below" are to be added to the Establishment of Stores (Vote 2 "N") at each Division, and each Division should include this quantity in 1941 Estimates "D.o.F. C.".

6. Appendix VII, Store Instructions, R.M., has been amended by G.O. of today's date.
