Royal Marine Labour Company.


With reference to Circular R.M. of this number dated 4th January, 1940, the Royal Marine Labour Company will be/ entered at the Plymouth Division, R.M.

2. Arrangements are being made for Major E.C. Jarvis to be called up and to report at the Plymouth Division, R.M., for duty - date to be reported.

3. The Clerk required is to be provided by the Chatham Division and the 4 N.C. Officers by the Plymouth Division. The first batch of men for this unit will consist of 100, the remainder being called up later.

4. Separate records are to be kept for men entered for this Unit, separate Register Numbers being allocated and prefixed by the letters "L.C.", ranks being referred to as "L.C./..... Marine....., R.M.".

5. The Officer Commanding the Unit is to render a return, on the lines of the enclosure hereto, fortnightly, to the Adjutant General, R.M., the first return being rendered on 13th January, 1940, and will continue to be rendered when the unit is drafted for service.
