


CIRCULAR

DRUM MAJOR'S STAVES.

With reference to R.M.O.Circular of this number dated 8th March 1929 and replies thereto, it has been decided to standardise the Staves supplied for Divisional and Depot use as opportunity offers. The Staves of the Portsmouth and Plymouth Divisions and the Depot R.M., Deal, are mainly alike and it has been decided to adopt this type as standard, subject to the following modifications :-

- (a) The Crown to be replaced by an Imperial Crown.
- (b) Chains of sterling silver to be used instead of Cord, Gold.
- (c) The bugle on shank immediately below the Globe to be deleted. It is for consideration whether any emblem should be substituted in the space left blank.
- (d) The Royal Cypher "W.IV" to be replaced by the Royal Cypher "G.IV" or by the Cypher of the reigning monarch. It would avoid change on the demise of the Crown if the Cypher "G.IV" was adopted.
- (e) It is intended that the continents should be shewn on the Globe.

2. Commandants R.M., will please furnish their remarks on this. Sketches of the four staves now in use have been circulated to R.M. Establishments under separate cover.



dated 20th March, 1929.

The present Staff at the Depot, R.M. is reputed to be that originally issued to the Woolwich Division and is consequently of great historical interest, it is therefore not desired to make any alteration until a new issue becomes necessary.

On the issue of a new Staff, the modifications proposed in (a), (b) and (e) are concurred in. It is considered that the space referred to in (c) should be left blank, and that the Royal Cypher of the reigning monarch at the time of issue should be included, and not changed on the demise of the crown.



Adoption of a standard pattern.

The Drum Major's Staff now in use at the Plymouth Division R.M., is in need of replacement and it is therefore requested that action may be taken by your Department for the purchase of a new Staff as a charge against Vote 2 "N". A formal requisition is enclosed.

It is desired that the design and dimensions shall be in accordance with the accompanying sketch of an existing Staff, subject to the following modifications :-

- (i) The Crowns to be replaced by Imperial Crowns.
- (ii) Cord, Gold, Universal, to be replaced by chains of sterling silver.
- (iii) No bugle - space to be left blank.
- (iv) Royal Cypher "G.R. IV" to be replaced by that of the reigning monarch "G.R.V".
- (v) The Globe to be of sterling silver and the Continents of copper coloured metal.
- (vi) All parts shewn on sketch as being silver plated to be of sterling silver.

This design will be standard for future supplies to R.M. Divisions for Divisional and Depot use.

With reference to R.M.O. Circular of this number dated 20th March 1929 and replies thereto, the type of Drum Major's Staff now in use at R.M. Divisions other than Chatham, and at the Depot R.M., Deal, will be adopted as standard, the following alterations being made when replacements become necessary :-

- (a) The Crowns to be replaced by Imperial Crowns.
- (b) The bugle to be omitted and the space left blank.
- (c) The Royal Cypher "G.R.IV" to be replaced by the Cypher of the reigning monarch. The latter not to be changed on the demise of the Crown.
- (d) The Continents to be shewn on the Globe.
- (e) Chains of sterling silver to be fitted to the Staff instead of Cord, Gold, Universal.

With reference to R.M.O. Circulating Minute of this number dated 20th March 1929 and your reply thereto No. S. 309/0.R. 38/29 dated 25th March 1929, records have now been traced in Office which disclose the fact that the Drum Major's Staff now in use at the Establishment under your Command was supplied to the Depot in 1892 or 1894 through the Director of Navy Contracts at a cost of £9. 15. 0. The impression that the Staff is that formerly in use at the Woolwich Division is therefore erroneous.

2. With regard to the Royal Cypher immediately below the bugle on the Staff, this is a faulty reproduction of that of George IV; the initial "W" appearing immediately below the stock of the anchor should have been the numeral "IV" as in the Regimental Colours and in the accompanying diagram.




