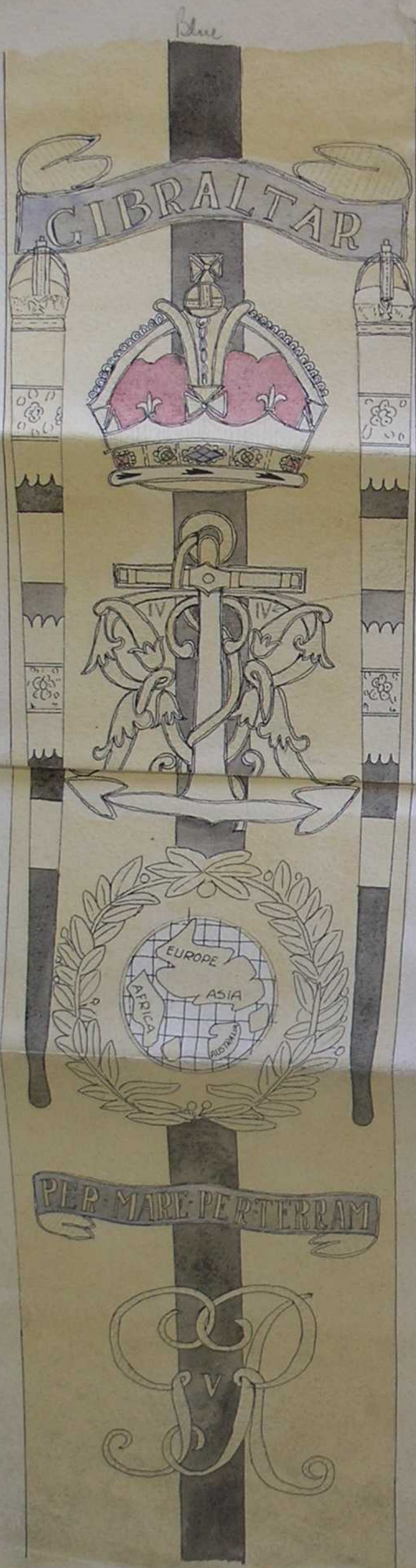

DETAIL.

- A** Golden Lion. $1\frac{1}{2}$ " high by $1\frac{3}{10}$ " long.
B — " — Rings Brown. $1\frac{9}{10}$ " high by $1\frac{1}{2}$ " long.
C Silver Globe, engraved continents, Oceans & meridians.
D Golden dome. $7\frac{1}{2}$ " long, $12\frac{1}{4}$ " ~~diameter~~ ^{circumference}. Engraved thus:-
 1 Oak leaves and acorns.
 2 Silver letters on roughened surface, the spaces above & below being polished.
 3 Oak leaves and acorns.
 4 Roughened space.
 5 Floral Design consisting of Roses, Thistles, Shamrocks and their leaves.
 6 Silver letters on plain ground.
 7 Prince of Wales' Plume.
 8 Engraved band.
 9 Plain.
 10 Rope design.
 11 Plain.

All engraving is on roughened surface but the irregular space between 4-10 is polished.

E A Golden band, floral design and carrying 2 loops for Tassels & Cord.

F Tapping Malacca cane 3ft long, and tapering from $1\frac{1}{2}$ " at 10 to 1" top of 'H' inserted and secured by Brass screws.

G Gold Tassels & Cord. Passed through 2 l 'E' & 'H' and secured.

H Tapering Brass Ferrule $18\frac{1}{2}$ " long, $\frac{1}{2}$ " at base 1" at top.

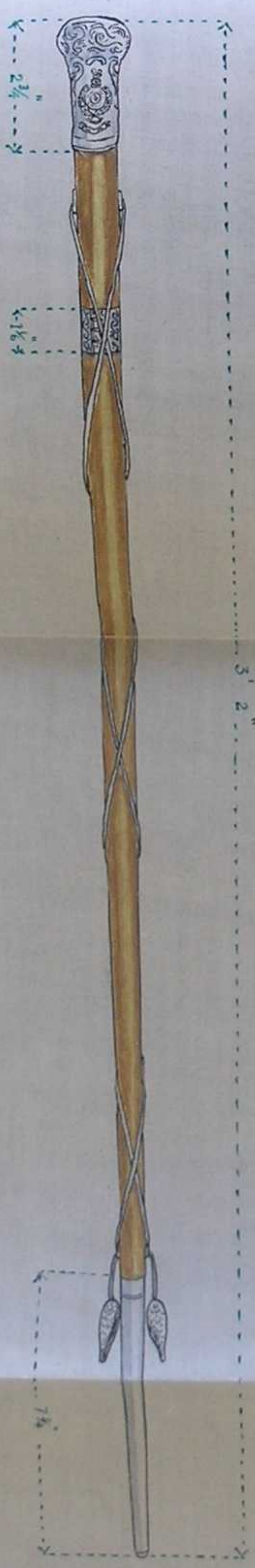
