**\*106. ROYAL MARINES BAND SERVICE - SHOULDER TITLE FOR JERSEY WOOL HEAVY**

1. The bugler section and the musician section officers and trained ranks  
are to wear a Royal Marines Band Service shoulder title on the jersey wool  
heavy with effect from 1 October 1979. In design it is similar to the

Royal Marines Commando shoulder title.

2. Stocks have been manufactured and are now available to bands as a free issue of 1 pair to each musician and bugler. Ranks undergoing initial training are not entitled to wear the shoulder titles.
3. Buglers are to continue to wear their authorised dress for the time being. A review of Royal Marines Band Service ceremonial dress will occur in May 1980.
