

Approval has been given for the Ceremonial Arm Badge formerly worn by Colour Sergeants with the Cloth Tunic to be re-introduced in a smaller size for wear with the present No 1 Dress. An AFO will be promulgated when the arm badge becomes available for issue.

2. The arm badge was first introduced in August, 1814, and was awarded to a number of selected Sergeants as a reward for the meritorious and exemplary conduct of the Non-Commissioned Officers of the Corps. A copy of the Admiralty letter announcing the original introduction of the badge is reproduced as an Appendix to this Order.
