The following regulations regarding the wearing of Commando insignia are promulgated. The Appendix to the Navy List (Page 148, Section II, paras 1 and 2) will be amended in due course.

2. The Green Beret

- (a) Will be worn only by
  - (i) All ranks (of any Service) posted to a Commando Formation or Commando Unit (Regular or RMFVR).
  - (ii) Instructors at the Commando School and such members of the Permanent Staff of the School as the Commandant shall decide (under RM 15/12/54 dated 24th April, 1951).
- (b) The Green Beret will be worn either :-
  - (i) On joining the posted strength of a Commando Formation or Unit, or
  - (ii) On presentation of the Green Beret at the end of the Commando Course under RM 15/12/54 dated 28th May, 1951, whichever is the earlier.

3. The flash "Royal Marines Commando" will only be worn by all Royal Marines ranks who wear the Green Beret under the terms of para 2 above.

4. The "Dagger" sign is the Commando formation sign and will only be worn by all ranks (of any Service) while on the posted strength of a Commando Formation or Unit.

5. The flash "Royal Marines Commando" and "Dagger" sign will only be worn on battledress. The Green Beret will be worn with the dresses authorised in the Royal Marines Dress Regulations in the Appendix to the Navy List.
