

256 THE DUKE OF EDINBURGH'S TROPHY—WEARING OF MEDALLIONS AWARDED TO WINNERS

Medallions awarded in connection with the Duke of Edinburgh's Trophy are to be worn in uniform by both officers and other ranks only on occasions when the Duke of Edinburgh visits RM units in his capacity as Captain General.

2 It will be worn centrally on the pleat of the right breast pocket with the top of the Coronet $\frac{1}{4}$ " below the bottom of the pocket flap.

3 The Medallion is 1.4" in diameter and consists of a circular centre piece surrounded by a wreath of laurels and surmounted by a Coronet and with a brooch fastner. The centre piece shows on the obverse crossed rifle and SMG. The reverse is blank.

4 Brief details of the competition were promulgated in Notices to RMROs dated 9th December, 1957.

5 Dress regulations will be amplified accordingly.
