

289 ISSUE OF KHAKI TIE TO RM BAND RANKS AND BUGLERS

1. At present only those ranks of the RM Band Service and Buglers drafted to a Commando formation or unit are entitled to the issue of a khaki tie. In order that those ranks who have not already been issued with a tie should have one to wear with lovat uniform, the following arrangements have been approved :—
 - a. **Ranks serving on or before 31st March, 1964 who have not already been issued with a tie.** To be given a free issue of one tie, worsted, braid, drab, at the time they receive the issue of a lovat uniform, under the arrangements promulgated in AFO 1861/63, Appendix B, Paragraph 2 (i). Issue of the tie is to be recorded on the Kit History Sheet (Form R 48a).
 - b. **Ranks who join on or after 1st April, 1964.** One tie, worsted, braid, drab to be included in the initial scale of kit.
2. Officers of the RM Band Service, who receive the same outfit allowance as other RM Officers (which includes an allowance for 2 ties khaki), will be required to provide their own ties.
