

Berets, Blue - Replacement of Scarlet Patches.

Scarlet patches on blue berets which become too dirty to be renovated or which become unserviceable may be replaced at the public expense unless replacement is necessary owing to neglect on the part of the wearer. In the latter case, cost of replacement will be recovered in accordance with RMOM 39.

2. Patches will be cut from Cloth, Scarlet, No. 4, 56-in., Patt. T47 and will be manufactured at Divisions. HQ Supplies may be demanded direct by other establishments, formations and units.

3. The charge for sewing on patches by RM tailors at HQ Divisions or unit tailors is 1d per patch. When skilled service labour is not available the cost may be recovered in accordance with RMOM 21 and, in the case of ranks borne on ships books, AFO 4962/44.

4. Issuing price is 2d per patch.

5. Issues to officers will be made on repayment in accordance with BR 141(44) paragraph 3.
