Item 1

Eve started a children's home in Uganda where she helps disadvantaged children. She operated for some time but due to increasing expenditures which she could no longer meet, she applied to a charity organization for help. Fortunately, her request was granted and she was asked to make a budget following the guidelines given by the charity organization as shown below;

- Medical fund for each child per term according to age:
4-8 years is 200,000/=, 9-13 years is 100,000/= and above 13 years is 75,000/=.
- School fees for each child per term is 500,000/= and 750,000/= for primary and secondary school children respectively.
- The budget should clearly indicate the total amount spent on each child per term and the overall amount Eve expects per year.

The organization has scheduled a meeting for all the institutions it helps and Eve is expected to make a presentation of the activities done by the children at the home, available facilities, future plans and the budget.

Eve has details of the children's home and the data to be included in the budget in the **children's file folder**, however, she lacks the ICT skills.

Task:

Help Eve to prepare all that she needs to present in the meeting.
