2.2: TEACHING AND LEARNING ACTIVITIES:

We started the Term on Monday 26th May, 2025 and all activities have gone on well as planned. The Skilling School in a special way prepared the first cohort in S.3 for their final Assessment. We are very hopeful that they will perform very well and we will have our first Graduation. The E-Library has also been enhanced to allow easy access to learning materials. The Fine Art inter schools exhibition was also hosted at Mengo School.

2.3: VISITORS:

- We were blessed to receive the First lady and honourable Minister of Education and Sports, Hon. Janet Kataaha Museveni. She was our Chief Guest at the Thanksgiving Service when we thanked God for the 130years of existence. The Arch Bishop of the Church of Uganda was our Guest of Honour on our Fundraising Dinner as we collected funds for the Construction of our Mega Dining Hall. Bishop Nathan Ahimbisibwe, Bishop Katumba Tamale and Bishop Luzinda also visited us and prayed for us. We appreciate His Excellency Yoweri Kaguta Museveni and Maama Janet K. Museveni who donated Ugx.100, 000,000/- as their contribution to the construction of the Mega Dining Hall.
- As part of the 130 years Anniversary celebrations, the Buganda Government was well represented by Owek. Robert Serwanga, Minister for Youth, Sports, and Arts. We were privileged to host Dr. Kedres Turyagenda, Permanent Secretary in the Ministry of Education and Sports, Mrs. Juliet Atuhaire Muzoora- the Commissioner Government Secondary, Head teachers and other members in the Education Sector.
- This term we were glad to receive His Excellency the Ambassador of the United States of America- Hon. William W. Pop on 5th June, 2025. He attended a lesson with the Senior ones and made an address to the School on Career Success in line with the American Embassy.
- On 6th August, we had the honour of hosting the Bishop of Namirembe Diocese, the Rt. Rev. Moses Banja together with Bp. Wilberforce Kityo Luwalira and Maama Faith Luwalira on the Pastoral visit. He confirmed 109 students into the Anglican faith, named the Library Laboratory Block in honour of Bishop Wilberforce Kityo Luwalira, and laid a foundation stone for the construction of a 26-classroom block.
- We have also had so many schools bench-marking with us and we praise the Lord for what we learnt from them.
- The Careers Week, Thanksgiving and Achievers' Day were successfully held on 13th June 2025. We hosted a number of parents and other stakeholders. On this day we bade our former Chaplain Rev. Paul Nsubuga Mugabi and Maama Lillian Nsubuga farewell. He was appreciated for the good work he did while with us and for his Service as a School Chaplain.

2.4: OTHER ENGAGEMENTS:

- i. Laurenciana Muwonge of S.4 S emerged as the best performer in the FIT German exams organized by the Goethe-Institut in Nairobi. She was awarded a scholarship to attend a B1 seminar in Hamburg, Germany from 1st to 22nd June, 2025 where she performed well.
- ii. The election of the Baganda Nkobazambogo national leadership was concluded successfully, with Makumbi Benjamin of S.3 B elected as the Vice Chairperson, and Nambi Peninah of S.3 E as the Chairperson for Women Affairs.
- iv. Some selected students attended the Annual National Science Fair organized in the city centre and their performance was outstanding.
- v. In Sports, Walusimbi Kirabo G. of S.4 W represented school in the U16 Basketball championship in Tanzania and qualified for Afrobasket.
- vi. In related developments, Okello Daniel of S.6 Violet emerged as the best Mathematician for A'Level in Uganda.
- vii. On international scale, Nakacwa Emmanuella and Aweebwa Nicole Banks of S.3 Maroon represented school at the ODM Model United Nations and cultural event in India. Nicole won Best delegate award of the MUN, 2025. She has been Delegate of Paraguay of the United Nations Social, Humanitarian and Cultural committee.
- viii. In football, the under 14 Boys' team emerged as the second runners up in the regional qualifiers and were awarded Bronze medals. Our Ludo team won the National championship.
- ix. In wood-ball, we are the national champions this year. We want to thank the Lord so much for all these achievements.
- x. The open-air campaigns were concluded on Wednesday, paving way for E-voting on Thursday 24.7.25. The elections ended with Bakayita Aaron 5M as Head Prefect, Lwanga Elijah Brown 5W as Deputy Head Prefect and Nyanzi Gift 5V as Head girl.
From the students' council, Hon. Lule Jerome Ssali was elected Chairperson with Hon. Musinguzi Ryan Ezra as the Speaker.
- xi. The FUFA TV tournament is on and our school team qualified for the last under 16 scheduled for 1st - 9th September in St. Josephs Layibi College, Gulu.

3.0: DISCIPLINE:

We have not had any serious indiscipline this term and we commend our students for upholding the core values of the school. We pray that they keep the spirit. Guidance and Counselling has been done and sensitization and involvement of student leaders in handling fellow students has continued.

4.0: OBITUARY:

This term we have lost a number of parents, friends and loved ones. We continue to condole with the bereaved families and pray that God continues to intervene in their families.

5.0: CHAPLAINCY DEPARTMENT:

We have continued to conduct three Sunday Services as follows; The First one from 7:00am – 8:30am in English, the Second from 9:00 – 10:30am in English and the Third one from 11:00 – 12:30pm in Luganda. During holidays we shall have only two services at 9:00am and at 11:00am.

6.0: THE DONORS' CLUB AND TAMBULA MENGO DRIVE:

We want to thank you so much for moving this journey with us especially when you guided our learners. The 'Tambula Mengo' drive yielded Ugx.60,000,000/=. A new innovation of an online Tambula Mengo platform has been introduced. We shall share more during Class-days.
