

SECTION A:

Item 1.

Your community had people belonging to the same tribe with similar cultural practices. In the recent past however, it has attracted people from different tribes with totally different cultures. This has made the original settlers develop a bad attitude towards new comers. Some have approached the local leaders requesting them to chase the new comers so they do not disorganize the culture of the community.

In response, your local leaders have called for a meeting involving all community members to explain to the original settlers why they need new comers and also to ask both groups to respect each other's culture. The local leaders lack organized information to use during the meeting and have requested you to help them compile it.

Task: In a detailed document, write information the local leaders will use to explain to the above people;

- a) The need for new comers in their community.
- b) Why they should respect each other's culture.

Item 2.

Between 1939-1945, the world was faced with the 2nd major war. This involved different countries in the World either fighting on the side of the Germans or the British. East African countries fought on the British side. To many historians, it is good this war broke out because if it had not occurred, the region would perhaps still be under colonial rule. To them, the outbreak of this War enabled the people of East Africa to use different approaches/methods in order to fight for their independence which was finally granted in the early 1960s.

SECTION B:

Item 3.

Uganda is a multi-party country. Many political parties are operating in the country including Democratic Party (DP), National Unity Platform (NUP), National Resistance Movement (NRM), Justice Forum (JEEMA) among others. Item 4.

Due to continued indirect foreign influence/ control over African countries by super powers since independence, African leaders have embraced regional integration as a way of fighting this situation (neo-colonialism). In 1999, Uganda, Kenya and Tanzania revived the operations of the East African community that had collapsed in 1977.
