Other than the requirements given in the scenario, the artwork should also be guided by the following:

- (a) The size of the working surface for drawing/painting should be 45cm x 55cm.*
- (b) The working area for fabric designs and decorative/surface designs should be 45cm x 60cm.*
- (c) 3-Dimensional artworks should be about 30cm high.*
- (d) Relief artworks should be about 25cm x 30cm.*

Item 1.
